Customizations

How far can your developers go with SharePoint Online?

What you get:

- ❑ Create Designer workflows
- ❑ Modify and create master pages, page layouts
- ❑ Create content types and taxonomy
- ❑ Create custom site templates
- ❑ Use the Data Form Web Part to create mashups
- ❑ SharePoint Web Services
- ❑ Create InfoPath Forms — no code allowed
- ❑ Javascript / jQuery

What you don't get:

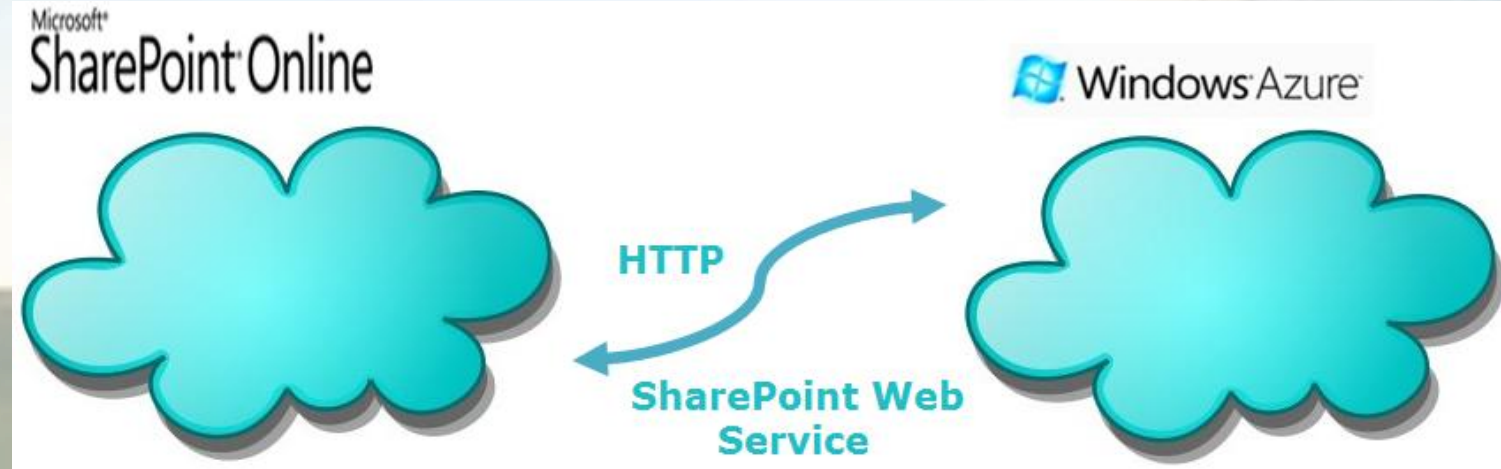
- ❑ No code in InfoPath Forms or custom coded workflows
- ❑ Can't create features, site definitions, web parts, solutions — anything that requires something be installed and configured on the server.
- ❑ You also can't modify SharePoint files, web.config settings or security
- ❑ No custom database modifications
- ❑ No configuration changes that affect the web server or the .NET framework

SharePoint Happenings

- Using an Azure application that consumes your online SharePoint Web services or over HTTP



- Do stuff like manage documents, security, web parts, site provisioning, run searches, etc.
